If you know of anyone who would like to tune in, but are unable to do so, you might help them with the task.

Booked Mass Intentions - Those who have booked Mass Intentions for dates during the period of public Mass cancellation should contact Fr. Martin if they wish those Masses to be deferred to a future date when Mass will be open to the public again. Otherwise, the Masses will be offered (privately) on the dates and times originally requested. These Masses will be live streamed and can be viewed from the parish website – www.straideparish.com. It is possible to reschedule Masses for after June 29th when, hopefully, public Masses will resume.

Offertory Envelopes - The present batch run out at the end of June. A sincere thanks to all of you who support the running of the parish through contributing each week in your offertory envelope. It shows your pride in, and support of, your parish community. We would not survive without that weekly support. As I organise the new sets of boxes, if there is anyone not getting a box at the moment, and wishes to have one, please let me know and I will organise it for you. Likewise, if there is anyone who wishes to discontinue, please let me know also.

The Sick & Housebound – will not be visited this month. Urgent sick calls will continue to be attended to.

Churches Reopening – Hopefully, from June 29th Churches will be able to reopen for public Masses again.
