Message from Straide Community Alert Group (SCAG) - Myself Bernie Lingard, as Secretary of SCAG, and Michael Kelly, as Chairperson, were asked to participate in a Zoom meeting by *Muintir Na Tire*. This is a meeting which usually takes place annually along with *An Garda Siochana* Castlebar and members of Committee Members from the Western Area.

As many will be aware, the Texts seem to have come to a standstill a couple of years ago which was highlighted by most group members. Garda Olive McCarthy agreed to look into these concerns.
