The Dominican friar renowned retreat leader, Donagh O'Shea, observes that "a deep truthful interiority is essential to a Christian life. A tree has to sink its roots deep into the ground, otherwise it comes down in the first storm ... Our actions, our lives, like trees, emerge from a rich darkness, silence and stillness".

The great German-Swiss poet, Hermann Hesse, writes: "A tree says: 'My strength is trust. I know nothing about my fathers, I know nothing about the thousand children that every year spring out of me. I live out the secret of my seed to the very end, and I care for nothing else. I trust that God is in me. I trust that my labour is holy. Out of this trust I live'".


